
To achieve this, we provide services in home, at our center, and in the community. We are collaborative and value working with family members, school staff, and other treatment providers.

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA)

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is a type of therapy that focuses on improving specific behaviors, such as social skills, communication, and adaptive living skills (i.e., hygiene, grooming, domestic capabilities). Behavior analysis focuses on the principles that explain how learning takes place.

ABA is commonly practiced as a therapeutic intervention for individuals with autism. COR Behavioral offers the following services which are consistent with the principles of ABA:

- Discrete Trial Instruction
- Social Skills Development
- Functional Behavior Assessment
- Early Intervention
- Consultation & Training





Our behavioral therapies are tailored to help each client reach his or her full potential. Our Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) use this information to develop individualized treatment goals and to implement the treatment program.



Assessments

School Consultation

Adaptive & Behavioral Fitness

Home Based Consultation & Therapy

Our in-home ABA Therapy is administered by trained Behavior Technicians in one-on-one sessions under the supervision of a Board-Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA). We focus on goals that encompass the full range of emerging skills and daily routine, as well as teaching functional and adaptive skills.

Social Skills Group

These groups are designed for children on the autism spectrum but are open to any and all children who may benefit from additional social skills development. These groups are designed to help your child practice emerging social skills in a safe environment and gain social confidence.

Center-Based Therapy Program

This program is comprehensive and ideal for learners ages 2-7 with autism and other developmental disabilities, who can benefit from an intensive full-time supportive learning environment

Functional Behavior Assessment (FBA)

FBA is a process for gathering information about the cause or function of challenging behavior. This information is used to develop efficient and effective behavioral interventions.

Parent Training

Parent training is an important component of any successful treatment program for a child with autism. Research has consistently shown that when parents are involved in the ABA therapy process, outcomes are more positive. Parent training gives family members an opportunity to learn and practice effective ABA strategies, which has been shown to help maintain progress.
