Short-Term Residential (STR)

- Serving 13-18 year old males and females with Moderate to Severe Substance Use Disorders
- ASAM Level 3.7 (Medically Monitored Intensive Inpatient Treatment)
- ✤ Average length of stay: 2-3 months

Withdrawal Management (Detox)

- Safe, Medical Monitoring of Withdrawal Symptoms
- Children's System of Care (CSOC) Funding-NO COST to families
- Serving Adolescents ages 13-19 years
