Short-Term Residential (STR)

- ❖ Serving 13-18 year old males and females with Moderate to Severe Substance Use Disorders
- ❖ ASAM Level 3.7 (Medically Monitored Intensive Inpatient Treatment)
- ❖ Average length of stay: 2-3 months

Withdrawal Management (Detox)

- ❖ Safe, Medical Monitoring of Withdrawal Symptoms
- ❖ Children's System of Care (CSOC) Funding-NO COST to families
- ❖ Serving Adolescents ages 13-19 years

- ❖ 24/7 Medical Monitoring
- ❖ On site Psychiatrist
- ❖ Family Education & Family Therapy
- ❖ On site schooling & GED Prep
