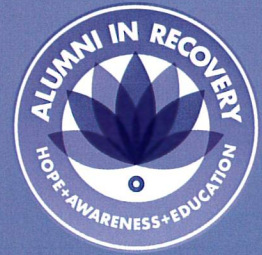


AinR™ Programs

Option 1: Substance Use Prevention Presentation

Option 2: Substance Use Prevention Presentation with Law Enforcement

PRESENTED BY RECOVERY OR PARENT SPEAKERS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT

Program features either an SRO or a local police officer, a Recovery Member and/or Parent Member. Provides an overall view of the dangers of fentanyl, prevention-addiction-overdose awareness, the importance of safety.

Safe Summer - Good Choices Program

PRESENTED BY RECOVERY SPEAKERS WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT

School Program Presentation for 8th Grade Students as they transition to high school. Designed to help youths make good choices over the summer – a peak time for experimentation. Young people in recovery speak alongside local police, reinforcing key points, and their personal experiences at that age, to prevent substance misuse.



United to Stop the OD Crisis Program

PRESENTED BY LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT, PARENT SPEAKERS AND COMMUNITY RESOURCE PARTNERS

This program highlights how community works together to provide support. An assembly-style presentation for high school or middle school students discussing: the dangers of fentanyl - "One Pill Can Kill", asking for help and identifying emotions, overdose awareness and prevention, addiction and the path to recovery, practicing kindness and supporting peers, The Good Samaritan Law, understanding and accessing Naloxone (Narcan), and promoting strong mental health habits.
