NEW JERSEY YOUTH CORPS

New Jersey Youth Corps is administered by the New Jersey Department of Labor & Workforce Development. It was established in 1984 and has successfully worked with over 25,000 young adults who want a chance at a brighter future!

New Jersey Youth Corps is a year-round, voluntary program designed for young adults, ages 16-25 that did not complete high school. Youth Corps breaks the cycle of limited opportunity by giving youth a second chance to earn a high school diploma while developing employment skills through meaningful community service. New Jersey Youth Corps offers the following services:



Team works on projects that benefit the community, such as landscaping or beautification, or help in hospitals, food banks and senior centers. These projects help the community, while providing Corpsmembers with valuable socialization skills.

PERSONAL & CAREER COUNSELING

Constant supportive counseling is provided by the Youth Corps. This includes personal counseling and career counseling designed to help remove barriers to academic and employment success.

Corpsmembers participate in Employability & Life Skills instruction, as well as individual and group counseling to build self-esteem, clarify values and develop leadership skills.

CONTINUING SUPPORT SERVICES

Corpsmembers who successfully complete the program receive college referral services, job placement assistance, and a personal career portfolio.

LIVING ALLOWANCE

While enrolled in New Jersey Youth Corps, participants receive a weekly \$100.00 stipend for their overall participation in the program.

SUMMARY

Youth Corps breaks the cycle of unemployment by providing young men & women an opportunity for a second-chance!



EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT

A major goal of the New Jersey Youth Corps is to help young adults obtain a HSE (High School Equivalency.) a little more than half of the programs' time is dedicated to improving and developing the academic skills of Corpsmembers.

Youth Corps incorporates small group, total group, and individual assistance in its classes. Instructors design a plan tailored to each individual's needs. The plan combines academics with career-related goals, and instruction is incorporated into community service through service learning activities.

WORK EXPERIENCE / COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS

Service Projects provide controlled, supervised work situations where Corpsmembers can develop maturity skills that are essential to being a good employee. Corpsmembers work in a team, or 'crew' led by experienced Crew Supervisors. The
