How are appointments scheduled? Call Turning Point Admissions **(973) 239-4600** for your current clients who need help. TP will conduct a phone screen and let you know their treatment and funding options, and schedule an appointment. Detox appointments are typically handled same day. Residential appointments may require additional time to gather relevant medical and clinical information— but most can be scheduled within 24 hours

What should clients bring to treatment? 1) ID/Form of identification 2) Current medications, 3) Changes of clothing and Toiletries (brand new, unopened, alcohol free), 5) Cigarettes (brand new, unopened packs)

What happens during the admissions process?

- Complete registration paperwork, provide identification documents and insurance cards, and verify your insurance.
- Conduct a drug screen and pregnancy test (female clients).
- Undergo a medical and clinical assessment to verify/determine treatment needs and level of care placement.
- Sign releases of information and consent forms. Protocols, rules and treatment structures are explained.
- Inventory all valuables, money, and property. All property and valuables are stored in a locked/secure property room.

How long is treatment? All treatment stays are individually determined by client's clinical and medical needs. Detox/Withdrawal Management is typically 5-7 days, Short-Term Residential is typically 1 to 4 weeks and Long-Term Residential is typically 2-3 months.

What conditions exclude clients from admission into treatment? Active Eating Disorder, Active Self-Harming Behavior, Current Suicidal or Homicidal Ideations, Command Hallucinations, Recent Suicide Attempt (active attempt), open wounds requiring IV treatment. Please contact the Admissions Team or your Community Outreach Representatives to discuss in greater detail.

Are clients on Methadone or Suboxone Maintenance excluded from treatment? No. For residential treatment, we will coordinate with your clients and their home clinics to facilitate continuation of their methadone maintenance. Individuals looking to detox from other substances (benzodiazepine, alcohol etc.) can usually do so while remaining on their methadone and suboxone maintenance. Coming Soon— clients will be able to stabilize and regulate their methadone doses through our new strategic relationship with Suburban Health Clinic.
