Crime Stoppers of Hunterdon County is operated by a Board of Directors comprised of local citizens who are governed by their By-Laws, raise funds and authorize disbursement of funds.

We are a member of Crime Stoppers USA, which spans the United States to build a network of local US programs that work together to help prevent and solve crimes in communities and schools across the nation.

Crime Stoppers uses a combination of anonymity and monetary rewards to encourage individuals to come forward with information about crimes.

HOW TO REPORT A CRIME

There are four ways to report a crime while remaining completely anonymous.

1. **Call the tip line at 1.800.321.0010**
(phone line has no recording device.)
 2. **Submit online at:**
www.crimestoppershunterdon.com
Click on "Tips" and fill out the online form
 3. **Text HCTIPS and your tip to:**
274637 (CRIMES)
 4. **Download free mobile app:**
"Tipsubmit" by Public Engines

HOW TO GET CASH REWARDS

Cash rewards of up to \$1,000 per incident are distributed anonymously to people who give information leading to an arrest or indictment. All tipsters remain anonymous with no pressure to reveal their identity.

- At the time of the incident report, the tipster will be given a tip number and password (for an online submitted tip), a code number (for a call-in tip) or a unique text-code (for a tip submitted via texting).
- The tipster may check the status of their report by going online with their tip number and password and clicking the link under "check the status," by texting with their code number with a tip that was sent via texting, or by calling the tip hotline: 1.800.321.0010 using their code number.
- After an arrest or indictment, the tipster will be advised how and where to pick up their cash reward. Crime Stoppers is unable to notify the tipster if the tip was submitted via the hotline.
