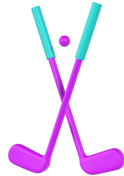
In-Person Events: Past events include bowling, diners, etc.

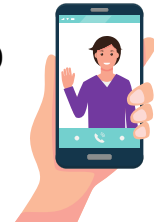
Virtual Events: Log in to the Zoom group to participate in conversation and games.
