- Primary and specialty care, including check-ups and other visits
- Eye Glasses
- Hospitalization (both inpatient and outpatient)
- Lab tests/x-rays
- Prescriptions
- Dental Services
- Preventive Screenings
- Vaccinations
- Mental Health Care
- Substance Use Testing and Treatment
- Vision Services
- Hearing Services
- Lead Screening
- Family Planning
- Other medically necessary services

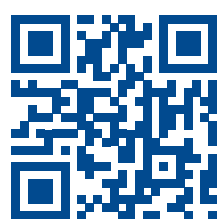
