Overview

Lifelines® is a whole-school program that educates administrators, faculty and staff, parents/guardians, and students on the facts about suicide and their roles in suicide prevention, intervention, and postvention.



Program Goal

The goal of Lifelines is to create a caring, competent school community in which help-seeking is encouraged and modeled and suicidal behavior is recognized as an issue that cannot be kept secret.

Lifelines aims to increase the likelihood that:

- members of the school community can more readily identify students at risk for suicide, know how to initially respond to them, and know how to rapidly obtain help for them.
- troubled students are aware of and have immediate access to helping resources and seek such help.

Lifelines Postvention: Responding to Suicide and Other Traumatic Death

Postvention Training, 6.5 hours Attended by: PreK – 12 crisis teams, community stakeholders, key faculty or staff from all schools

Lifelines Intervention: Helping Students At Risk for Suicide

Intervention Training, 6.5 hours Attended by: PreK – 12 school counselors from all schools and key faculty or staff

Lifelines Prevention: Building Knowledge and Skills to Prevent Suicide

Prevention Training, 6 hours Attended by: Grades 5 – 12 school counselors and health/PE teachers
