Family Mentor Program

In-home support, information and advocacy to families of children with special needs. Specially trained and matched community volunteers, provide weekly home visits, for one year or more, to support families through difficult times. Social Groups:

Social Learning Group: For children or adolescents coping with Asperger's Syndrome, High Functioning Autism Spectrum Disorders or Other Social Skills Disorders

10 sessions on Sundays- Fee: \$300 for 10 sessions and 4 parent sessions

Young Adult Social Club- A Social Group for high school graduates with social needs. The group meets twice monthly in the community for social outings. Fee: \$10 per session

Parent Support Group- Educational and supportive group sessions for parents and caregivers of children with special needs.

Sibling Support Group- Peer Support and information for brothers and sisters of children with special needs.
